Dear Properties of Donsdale Homeowner,

In 2016, your volunteer board for The Properties of Donsdale Residents Association continued to work hard to manage and maintain our assets and provide value to our homeowners.

This year, the upkeep of our community was transitioned to Delta Valley Landscaping and Water Works Ponds. This has given us access to new expertise while reducing the overall costs to the Association. As there are many different areas and systems requiring care, this year has been a learning experience for all involved. Minor hiccups were inevitable and we were pleased to find these contractors very responsive to concerns raised. We look forward to working with these companies into the future.

With the intent of having clearer pond and waterways, the stream courses and concrete structures were extensively cleaned prior to pump start-up in the spring. During the summer, the streams were treated with eco-friendly bacterial supplements and clarifiers to reduce algal growth. Unfortunately, our plans to capitalize on these measures through aeration in the pond didn't come to fruition due to complications in running electricity to the compressor system. After exhausting all other avenues, we will be proceeding with a directional-drilling solution to provide power from our existing electrical panel. This will enable us to get the aerators running early in the spring. We anticipate much more pleasing views in 2017!


